(Paddington, QLD – February 5, 2010) - Fabritecture awarded contract to complete the architectural canopy membrane works, for Caxton Street Nightclub, Brisbane.

The form of the structure has been designed to provide visual projection onto the membrane, free from all steelwork and cables. This has been achieved by designing the gutter system to be supported from above, maintaining the structures aesthetic appeal. The gutter will appear to be floating high inside the structure, allowing complete control over projection options. Set for structural completion in late April, the anticipated nightclub is scheduled for opening, 1 May 2010.
