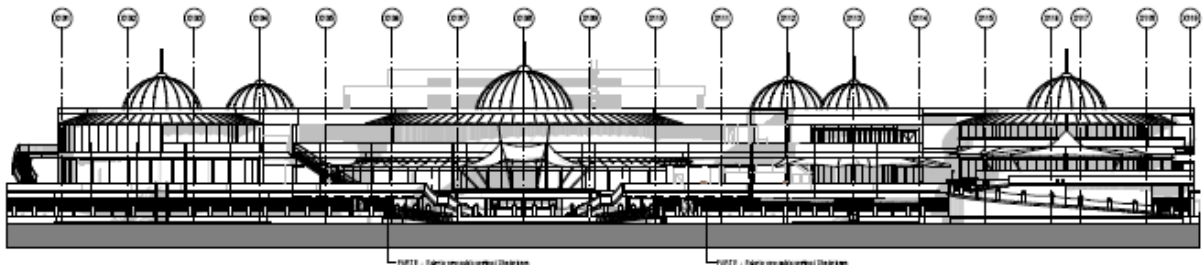

Fabritecture Awarded Contract to Construct Multiple Architectural Shade Sails for Eagle Street Pier Redevelopment

(Brisbane, QLD – July 29, 2010) - Fabritecture has been awarded a \$200K contract by Built QLD Pty Ltd, to provide the cladding for ten architectural shade sail structures as part of the Eagle Street Pier redevelopment in Brisbane.



The Eagle Street Pier is a portfolio of the Stockland Corporation Limited, one of Australia's largest retail property owners, managers and developers in Australia. Firmly established as one of Brisbane's favourite food and entertainment destinations, Eagle Street Pier is an iconic waterfront precinct with world class dining options and unrivalled views of the Brisbane River.

The shade sails will provide cover to various high traffic areas of Eagle Street pier, including a pedestrian ramp, the Coffee Club café, and the Jade Buddha Restaurant alfresco area and entrance. Six of the shade sails will be constructed using Chukoh FGT-600 PTFE membrane, the remainder using Ferrari Premium PVC.

Construction has already begun on the Eagle Street Pier redevelopment with Fabritecture expected to complete installation of the shade sails in October 2010.
